Appendix B

Coding criteria and sources used to classify regionalist parties

‘Before’ vs. ‘After’ party:

Regionalist parties created before the establishment of regional elections and the actual holding of the first regional election were coded as ‘before’. Regionalist parties created after the establishment and holding of regional elections were coded as ‘after’. In the cases of parties created between the passage of the legislation establishing regional elections and the actual holding of the first election, we coded as ‘before’ those that first participated in a national election, whereas we coded as ‘after’ those that first participated in the regional election.

‘Original’ vs. ‘Splinter’ party:

We coded as ‘splinter’ those parties that, according to the secondary sources listed below, originated from a split in an already existing regionalist party. These new parties, at least initially, draw on politicians/leaders, members and voters coming from the old parties from which they split. Examples are: *Vlaamse Blok/Belang* in Belgium (splinter from the *Volksunie*), *Fólkaflokkurin* in Denmark (splinter from *Sjálvstýrisflokkurin*), *Tiroler Heimatpartei* (splinter from the *Südtiroler Volkspartei*), *Eusko Alkartasuna* in Spain (splinter from the *Partido Nacionalista Vasco*). All other parties were coded as ‘original’.

‘Radicalizer’ party:

We coded as ‘radicalizer’ every ‘splinter’ party whose self-government claims were more radical than those of the regionalist party from which it originated. We relied on the coding scheme adopted in Massetti and Schakel (2013), reported below.
